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## THIS WEEK WE'RE LEARNING:

Jesus is alive and wants to be our friends forever!

Jesus makes breakfast for the disciples (John 21:1-14)

## MEMORY VERSE:

**I am alive forever and ever.**  
Revelation 1:18

## MOTIONS:

**I am alive** - Point both hands up  
**Forever and ever** - Twirl around

## PRAYER:

"Dear God, help us remember that Jesus is alive and we can celebrate Him every day. Thank you for loving us so much that you gave us Jesus. Amen."

## FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

### BREAKFAST WITH JESUS

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Play food or bowls, plates & utensils

Reenact the story together! Gather play food or bowls/plates and utensils and pretend to have breakfast with Jesus! Pretend making foods (flipping pancakes, breaking eggs, pouring milk...) and "eating" together.

Ask your kids what special foods they would enjoy if they had breakfast with Jesus. Ask them how they would feel seeing Jesus alive again. Take turns making surprised faces.

**WHAT YOU SAY:** Jesus' friends were so happy to see Jesus alive again! We can be happy too, because Jesus wants to be our friend forever.

### HELP ME SERVE

**What You Need:** Plate, ball and stuffed animals

Have your child set up a group of stuffed animals on one side of the room. Using the ball on the plate, tell your child you are going to pretend the ball is your breakfast and we need to serve it to our friends!

Guide them to carefully walk from one end of the room and back while balancing the ball (breakfast) on the plate. If they drop the ball, they may pick it back up and keep going. Have kids and grown ups all take a turn!

**WHAT YOU SAY:** Great job serving our friends! Today we heard about how Jesus prepared breakfast for His friends. Why were they so excited to see Jesus? Because He is alive!
