THIS WEEK WE'RE LEARNING:

God loves me no matter what!
(Luke 15:11-24)

MEMORY VERSE:

Nothing at all can separate us from God's love."

Romans 8:39 NIrV

MOTIONS:

Nothing at all - Shake head & wave hands in front of you
Can ever separate - lock fingers together

Us from God's - point up

Love - hug yourself

PRAYER:

"Dear God, thank you that You love us when we make good choices and when we don't. Thank you that you love us no matter what and nothing separates us from your love! In Jesus' name, amen."



FAMILY ACTIVITIES:

HIDE AND SEEK

Play a game similar to hide and seek. Have your child help you gather several of their stuffed animals, dolls or toys. Hide these items around the room. When you call them out have your child find them around the room. When the items are found, have your child shout "You were lost, but now you are found!"

CELEBRATION FEAST

Have a celebration feast! Have your child spread a tablecloth over the kitchen table and decorate it with anything you have to make it feel special (paper plates, streamers, confetti, balloons, or bright colored napkins.) Let your child(ren) enjoy a sweet treat.

While they are eating their treat, talk about the story of the prodigal son and thank God for his forgiveness when we make wrong choices and celebrate God's love.

PIG PEN

Using blocks, pillows or bins build a pig pen together with your child. Have your child(ren) pretend they are a pig in a stinky pig pen! Talk about how the son felt sad being away from his family and for the choices he made. Then celebrate that the son went home because his father loved him so much. Share with your child that God loves us that much too!
